In addition to humanitarian aid activities, SSE organizes symposiums, panels, career and training activities for the problems identified in the field and conducts common sense studies to produce permanent solutions globally. In this direction, SSE assumes a coordination role with a clear leadership by creating a space where actors/stakeholders can contribute to their activities and intervention efforts with its expert staff.

SSE is a formal institution that provides advisory services on all humanitarian issues for people affected by emergencies, as well as direct operational activities in mobilizing assistance and resources on behalf of the humanitarian system to overcome barriers that prevent aid from reaching people, while developing solutions to reduce humanitarian need, risk and vulnerability.

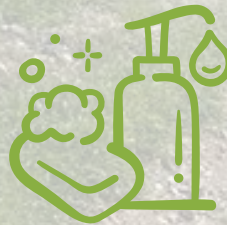

The identified families are evaluated according to the scoring system determined by visiting or contacting them through communication tools.



# OUR PROJECTS

## COMPLETED PROJECTS 1

### Earthquake Emergency Support Project

with Şahinbey Municipality and ZENSHO

At the time of the earthquake, cash support was provided and meals were delivered to families. In this project, ZENSHO, SSE and Şahinbey Municipality are the implementing partners of the project.



## COMPLETED PROJECTS 2

### Food Package Support Distribution Project for Earthquake Victims with WHH (Welthungerhilfe)

Within the scope of the project, 1500 food parcels were prepared and distributed in the earthquake zones of Adıyaman, Şanlıurfa and Şahinbey District. In this project, WHH (Welthungerhilfe) and SSE are project partners.



## COMPLETED PROJECTS 3

### Hygiene Kit Distribution Project

with Sahinbey Municipality

Within the scope of the project, 1000 hygiene parcels were prepared and distributed in the earthquake zones of Gaziantep with Sahinbey Municipality.



## CONTINUED PROJECT

# Skills for Empowerment Project with IOM (International Organization for Migration)

Within the scope of the project, 50 Turkish and 50 Syrian women are receiving handicrafts, entrepreneurship and e-commerce vocational trainings. At the same time, women are provided with cash support at the rate of one half of the minimum wage. In total, 100 women benefit from the project. This project is implemented by the Sustainable Social and Economic Development Association in partnership with the International Organization for Migration (IOM) and is funded by the US Department of the State's Bureau of Population, Refugees, and Migration.







## PROJECTS IN EVALUATION

### **Social Cohesion and Rehabilitation Through Sports Project with IOM (International Organization for Migration)**

Within the scope of the project, an carpet pitch will be built for 1000 children in the earthquake provinces of Adıyaman and Malatya to enable them to play sports. In addition, football kits will be purchased and earthquake traces will be reduced through sports.

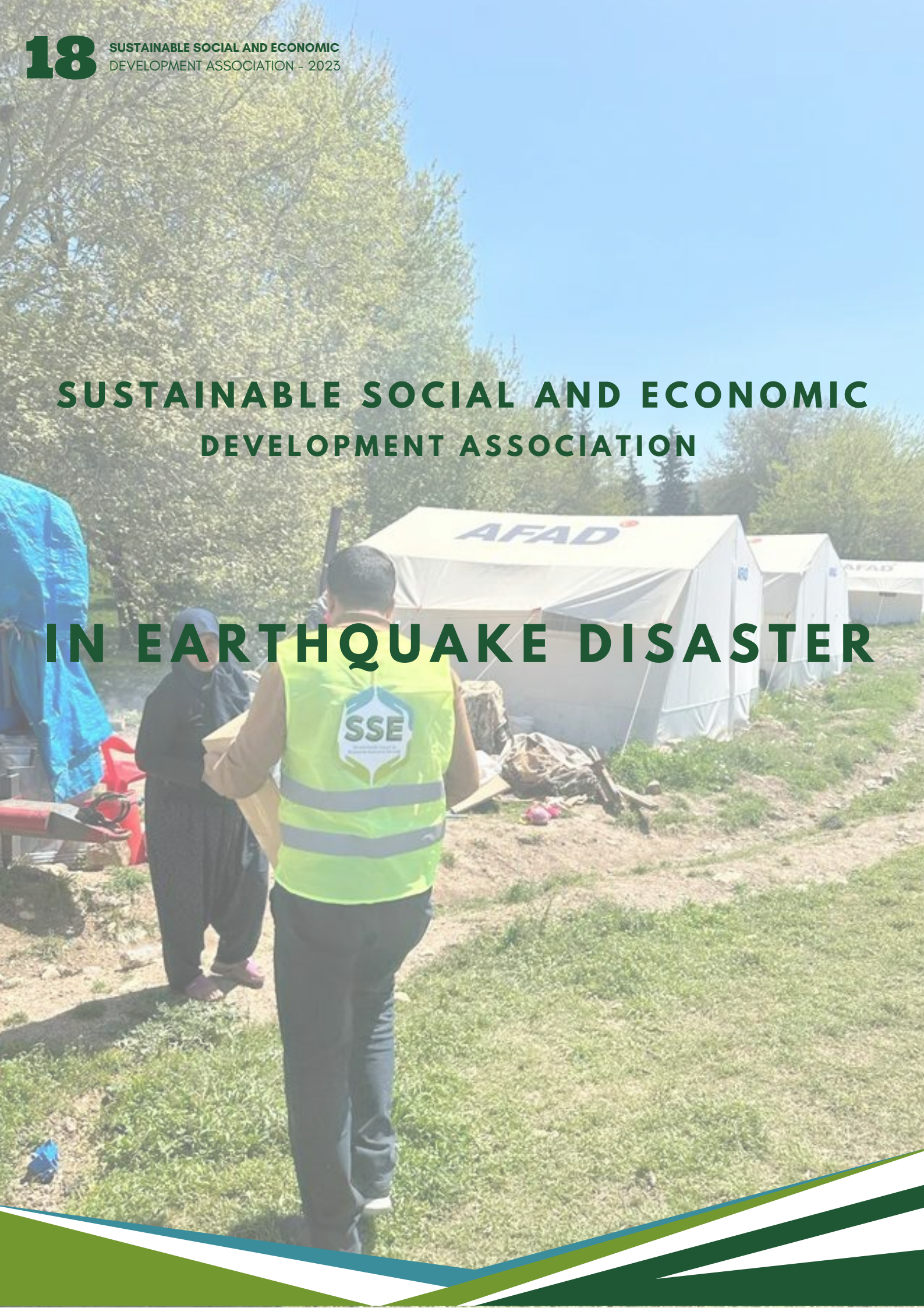

## SSE IN EARTHQUAKE DISASTER

### OUR PLANNED COOPERATION ACTIVITIES FOR FAMILIES AFFECTED BY THE EARTHQUAKE DISASTER

Our association, in cooperation with Şahinbey Municipality, has been actively working since the first moment of the earthquake. It has been actively involved in the field in meeting the food, hygiene, blanket and other basic needs of families in need.

Also to the distribution of 1500 food parcels with WHH in Adıyaman Şanlıurfa and Şahinbey district, 1500 hygiene packages with Şahinbey Municipality were distributed in the camp areas determined by AFAD.

Our association plans to develop projects not only in Gaziantep, but also in the districts affected by the earthquake (Adıyaman, Kahramanmaraş, Hatay, Malatya, Şanlıurfa, Nurdagi and İslahiye districts of Gaziantep) in the following priorities.

#### **PRIORITIZED NEEDS;**

- Ensuring that individuals living in container cities and tent areas have access to safe and clean water for drinking and cooking, and establishing and improving toilets and bathrooms.
- Increasing waste management capacity and fumigation.
- Provision of hygiene products (especially kits for women and children).

#### **Then for basic needs to be met;**

- We plan to provide 5,000 TL cash support to families affected by the earthquake to meet their needs.
- We plan to support families with shopping cards that they can use in markets such as A101 - BİM.
- We plan to reduce the effects of the earthquake by providing families with Food Parcels, Hygiene Kits, Stationery Kits for Children.
